Camille S. Biros and her colleague, Kenneth R. Feinberg, are nationally-recognized experts in the design, implementation and administration of public and private compensation programs. She currently serves as Director, Claims Administration at the Law Offices of Kenneth R. Feinberg.

In addition to the Independent Reconciliation and Reparations Program for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, Biros currently serves with her colleague Kenneth Feinberg as Fund Administrator for the New York Archdiocese Independent Reconciliation and Compensation Program and the Fund Administrator for the Brooklyn Diocese and Rockville Centre Diocese Independent Reconciliation and Compensation Programs, at the request of Cardinal Timothy Dolan.

She also served as Administrator for the DuPont Medical Monitoring Program; Deputy Administrator for the Gulf Coast Claims Facility after the BP Deepwater Horizon oil spill; and Deputy Special Master for the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund.

Ms. Biros has also served in a *pro bono* capacity in the design and implementation of the Las Vegas Victims Fund, OneOrlando Fund, One Fund Boston Victim Relief Fund, Newtown-Sandy Hook Victim Compensation Fund, Aurora Victim Relief Fund, and the Hokie Spirit Memorial Fund following the shootings at Virginia Tech University in 2007.

Prior to her work at the Law Offices of Kenneth R. Feinberg, Ms. Biros served as Administrator at Kaye, Scholer, Fierman, Hays & Handler, and opened a Washington, D.C. office for the national law firm.
